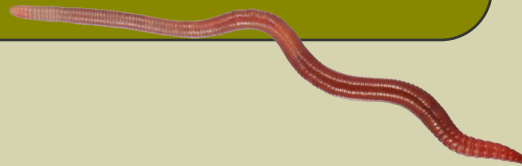


Worm Composting

Vermicomposting

Worm composting or **vermicomposting**, is a composting method that uses worms to break down the organic matter. The worms consume the organic material which then becomes compost after passing through their body.



Compost Worms

Red wigglers are a special type of worm that are used for composting. Unlike earthworms, they directly eat decaying organic matter. Red wigglers also tolerate the high temperatures associated with composting and thrive in the crowded environment.
